

# Safety Instructions

In the interest of your safety and to ensure the correct use, before installing and first using the appliance, read this user manual carefully, including its hints and warnings.

To avoid unnecessary mistakes and accidents, it is important to ensure that all people using the appliance are thoroughly familiar with its operation and safety features.

Save these instructions and make sure that they remain with the appliance if it is moved or sold, so that everyone using it through its life will be properly informed on appliance use and safety.

For the safety of life and property keep the precautions of these user's instructions as the manufacturer is not responsible for damages caused by omission.

#### Children and vulnerable people safety

- -This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given super vision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- -Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- -Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are aged from 8 years and above and supervised.
- -Keep all packaging well away from children. There is risk of suffocation.
- -If you are discarding the appliance pull the plug out of the socket, cut the connection cable (as close to the appliance as you can) and remove the door to prevent children to suffer electric shock or to close themselves into it.
- -If this appliance featuring magnetic door seals is to replace an older appliance having a spring lock (latch) on the door or lid, be sure to make that spring lack unusable before you discard the old appliance. This will prevent it from becoming a death trap for a child.

# Safety Instructions

#### General safety

**WARNING!** Keep ventilation openings, in the appliance enclosure or in the built-in structure, clear of obstruction.

**WARNING!** Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.

WARNING! Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.

**WARNING!** Do not use other electrical appliances (such as ice cream makers) inside of refrigerating appliances, unless they are approved for this purpose by the manufacture.

**WARNING!** Do not touch the light bulb if it has been on for a long period of time because it could be very hot.<sup>1)</sup>

- -Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- -The refrigerant isobutene (R600a) is contained within the refrigerant circuit of the appliance, a natural gas with a high level of environmental compatibility, which is nevertheless flammable.
- -During transportation and installation of the appliance, be certain that none of the components of the refrigerant circuit become damaged.
- avoid open flames and sources of ignition
- thoroughly ventilate the room in which the appliance is situated
- It is dangerous to alter the specifications or modify this product in any way. Any damage to the cord may cause a short circuit, fire and/or electric shock.
- -This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as
- staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
- farm houses and by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
- bed and breakfast type environments;
- catering and similar non-retail applications.

**WARNING!** Any electrical components (plug, power cord, compressor and etc.) must be replaced by a certified service agent or qualified service personnel.

**WARNING!** The light bulb supplied with this appliance is a "special use lamp bulb" usable only with the appliance supplied. This "special use lamp" is not usable for domestic lighting.<sup>1)</sup>

1) If there is a light in the compartment.

## Safety Instructions

- -Power cord must not be lengthened.
- -Make sure that the power plug is not squashed or damaged by the back of the appliance. A squashed or damaged power plug may overheat and cause a fire.
- -Make sure that you can come to the mains plug of the appliance.
- -Do not pull the mains cable.
- -If the power plug socket is loose, do not insert the power plug. There is a risk of electric shock or fire.
- -You must not operate the appliance without the lamp.
- -This appliance is heavy. Care should be taken when moving it.
- -Do not remove nor touch items from the freezer compartment if your hands are wet, as this could cause skin abrasions or frost/freezer burns.
- -Avoid prolonged exposure of the appliance to direct sunlight.

#### Notice before use

- -Do not put hot items on the plastic parts in the appliance.
- -Do not place food products directly against the rear wall.
- -Frozen food must not be re-frozen once it has been thawed out.1)
- -Store pre-packed frozen food in accordance with the frozen food manufacturer's instructions.1)
- -Manufacture's storage recommendations should be strictly adhered to. Refer to relevant instructions.
- -Do not place carbonated of fizzy drinks in the freezer compartment as it creates pressure on the container, which may cause it to explode, resulting in damage to the appliance.<sup>1)</sup>
- -lce lollies can cause frost burns if consumed straight from the appliance.<sup>1)</sup>

## Safety Instructions

#### Upon care and cleaning

- -Before maintenance, switch off the appliance and disconnect the mains plug from the mains socket.
- -Do not clean the appliance with metal objects.
- -Do not use sharp objects to remove frost from the appliance. Use a plastic scraper.<sup>1)</sup>
- -Regularly examine the drain in the refrigerator for defrosted water. If necessary, clean the drain. If the drain is blocked, water will collect into bottom of the appliance.<sup>2)</sup>
- 1) If there is a freezer compartment.
- 2) If there is a fresh-food storage compartment.

#### Upon installation

Important! For electrical connection carefully follow the instructions given in specific paragraphs.

- -Unpack the appliance and check if there are damages on it. Do not connect the appliance if it is damaged. Report possible damages immediately to the place you bought it. In that case retain packing.
  -It is advisable to wait at least four hours before connecting the appliance to allow the oil to flow back in the compressor.
- -Adequate air circulation should be around the appliance, lacking this leads to overheating. To achieve sufficient ventilation follow the instructions relevant to installation.
- -Wherever possible the spacers of the product should be against a wall to avoid touching or catching warm parts (compressor, condenser) to prevent possible burn.
- -The appliance must not be located close to radiators or cookers.
- -Make sure that the mains plug is accessible after the installation of the appliance.

#### Service

- -Any electrical work required to do the servicing of the appliance should be carried out by a qualified electrician or competent person.
- -This product must be serviced by our authorized Service Center, and only genuine spare parts must be used.

#### **Energy saving**

- -Do not put hot food in the appliance;
- -Do not pack food close together as this prevents air circulating;
- -Make sure food do not touch the back of the compartment(s):
- -If electricity goes off, do not open the door(s);
- -Do not open the door(s) frequently;
- -Do not keep the door(s) open for too long time;
- -Do not set the thermostat on exceeding cold temperatures;
- -Some accessories, such as drawers, can be removed to get larger storage volume and lower energy consumption.

## Safety Instructions

#### Environment protection

This appliance does not contain gasses which could damage the ozone layer, in either its refrigerant circuit or insulation materials. The appliance shall not be discarded together with the urban refuse and rubbish. The insulation foam contains flammable gases: the appliance shall be disposed according to the appliance regulations to obtain from your local authorities. Avoid damaging the cooling unit, especially the heat exchanger. The materials used on this appliance marked with the symbol  $\triangle$  are recyclable.



The symbol on the product or on its packaging indicates that this product may not be treated as household waste. 

## **Reverse Door**


#### **Reverse Door**

**Tool required**: Philips screwdriver, Flat bladed screwdriver, Hexagonal spanner.


- -Ensure the unit is unplugged and empty.
- -To take the door off, it is necessary to tilt the unit backwards. You should rest the unit on something solid so that it will not slip during the door reversing process.
- -All parts removed must be saved to do the reinstallation of the door.
- -Do not lay the unit flat as this may damage the coolant system.
- -It's better that 2 people handle the unit during assembly.
- 1. Remove the top right hinge cover.




2. Undo the screws. Then remove the hinge bracket.



3. Remove the top left screw cover.




4. Move the core cover from left side to right side. And then lift the upper door and place it on a padded surface to prevent it from scratching.



5. Unscrew bottom hinge. Then remove the adjustable feet from another side.






6. Unscrew and remove the bottom hinge pin with flat screw drivers, turn the bracket over and replace the pin.




7. Refit the bracket fitting the bottom hinge pin. Reinstall the adjustable foot.



- 8. Place the door back on. Ensure the door is aligned horizontally and vertically so that the seals are closed on all sides before finally tightening the top hinge.
- 9. Insert the hinge bracket and screw it to the top of the unit.
- 10. Use a spanner to tighten it if necessary.




11. Put the hinge cover and the screw cover back.


#### Rear spacer

Screw the rear spacers at the rear of the unit.



#### **Space Requirement**


- -Keep enough space of door open.
- -Keep at least 50mm gap at two sides.



#### Levelling the unit

Adjust the two levelling feet at front of the unit.

If the unit is not level, the doors and magnetic seal alignments will not be covered properly.



#### Location

Install this appliance at a location where the ambient temperature corresponds to the climate class indicated on the rating plate of the appliance.

Climate class	Ambient temperature
SN	+10°C to +32°C
N	+16°C to +32°C
ST	+16°C to +38°C

### Installation

The appliance should be installed well away from sources of heat such as radiators, boilers, direct sunlight etc. Ensure that air can circulate freely around the back of the cabinet. To ensure best performance, if the appliance is positioned below an overhanging wall unit, the minimum distance between the top of the cabinet and the wall unit must be at least 50 mm. Ideally, however, the appliance should not be positioned below overhanging wall units. Accurate leveling is ensured by one or more adjustable feet at the base of the cabinet.

**Warning!** It must be possible to disconnect the appliance from the mains power supply; the plug must therefore be easily accessible after installation.

#### Electrical connection

Before plugging in, ensure that the voltage and frequency shown on the rating plate correspond to your domestic power supply. The appliance must be earthed. The power supply cable plug is provided with a contact for this purpose. If the domestic power supply socket is not earthed, connect the appliance to a separate earth in compliance with current regulations, consulting a qualified electrician.

The manufacturer declines all responsibility if the above safety precautions are not observed.

This appliance complies with the E.E.C. Directives.

## **Operating Instructions**

#### First use

#### Cleaning the interior

Before using the appliance for the first time, wash the interior and all internal accessories with lukewarm water and some neutral soap so as to remove the typical smell of a brand new product, and then dry thoroughly.

Important! Do not use detergents or abrasive powders, as these will damage the finish.

#### **Temperature Setting**

- -Plug on your appliance. The internal temperature is controlled by a thermostat. There are 6 settings. 1 is warmest setting and 5 is coldest setting and 0 is off.
- -The appliance may not operate at the correct temperature if it is in a particularly hot or if you open the door often.



#### Daily use

#### Movable shelf

The shelf is able to be moved to suitable positions.



#### Positioning the door balconies

In order to storage food or beverage with different size, the door balconies can be placed at different height. Follow below process to adjust the shelves.

Step 1. Pull the balcony to be free.

Step 2. Select suitable position and press the balcony to two convex plates until it is totally blocked.

#### Vegetable Drawer

The drawer is suitable for storing fruit and vegetables. It can be pulled out freely.

#### Thawing

Deep-frozen or frozen food, prior to be used, can be thawed in a fridge compartment or at room temperature. Place the frozen food in a dish or bowl to avoid the flowing of condensate water when thaw it in compartment.

## **Operating Instructions**

#### Hints and tips

#### Hints for fresh food refrigeration

To obtain the best performance:

- -do not store warm food or evaporating liquids in the refrigerator
- -do cover or wrap the food, particularly if it has a strong flavor
- -position food so that air can circulate freely around it

#### Hints for refrigeration

Useful hints:

- -Meat (all types): wrap in polythene bags and place on the glass shelf above the vegetable drawer. For safety, store in this way only one or two days at the most.
- -Cooked foods, cold dishes, etc..: these should be covered and may be placed on any shelf.
- -Fruit and vegetables: these should be thoroughly cleaned and placed in the vegetable drawer.
- -Butter and cheese: these should be placed in special airtight containers or wrapped in aluminum foil or polythene bags to exclude as much air as possible.
- -Milk bottles: these should have a cap and should be stored in the bottle rack on the door.
- -Bananas, potatoes, onions and garlic, if not packed, must not be kept in the refrigerator.

## Cleaning and Maintenance

For hygienic reasons the appliance interior, including interior accessories, should be cleaned regularly.

**Caution!** The appliance may not be connected to the mains during cleaning. Danger of electrical shock! Before cleaning, switch the appliance off and remove the plug from the mains, or switch off or turn out the circuit breaker or fuse. Never clean the appliance with a steam cleaner. Moisture could accumulate in electrical components, danger of electrical shock! Hot vapors can lead to the damage of plastic parts. The appliance must be dry before it is placed back into service.

**Important!** Ethereal oils and organic solvents can attack plastic parts, e.g. lemon juice or the juice from orange peel, butyric acid, cleanser that contain acetic acid.

- -Do not allow such substances to come into contact the appliance parts.
- -Do not use any abrasive cleaners
- -Remove the food from the freezer. Store them in a cool place, well covered.
- -Switch the appliance off and remove the plug from the mains, or switch off or turn out the circuit breaker of fuse.
- -Clean the appliance and the interior accessories with a cloth and lukewarm water. After cleaning wipe with fresh water and rub dry.
- -Accumulation of dust at the condenser increases energy consumption. For this reason carefully clean the condenser at the back of the appliance once a year with a soft brush or a vacuum cleaner.<sup>1)</sup>
- -After everything is dry place appliance back into service.
- 1) If the condenser is at back of appliance.

# Cleaning and Maintenance

#### Replace the lamp


Caution! Before replacing the lamp, disconnect the appliance from mains power supply.

Lamp specification is listed in rating label.

Follow below process to replace the lamp:

- 1. Set the temperature regulation knob at number "0" to switch off the appliance.
- 2. Unplug the appliance to make sure the appliance is disconnected from main power supply.
- 3. Remove the lamp cover out by a flat screw driver.
- 4. Unscrew the lamp by fingers.
- 5. Fit new lamp according to the opposite direction, then replace the lamp cover.
- 6. Plug in the appliance and regulate the knob to right position.





#### Defrosting

The evaporator, however, will become progressively covered with frost. This should be removed. Never use sharp metal tools to scrape off frost from the evaporator as you could damage it. However, when the ice becomes very thick on the evaporator, complete defrosting should be carried out as follows: -pull out the plug from the socket;

- -remove all stored food, wrap it in several layers of newspaper and put it in a cool place;
- -keep the door open, and placing a basin underneath of the appliance to collect the defrost water;
- -when defrosting is completed, dry the interior thoroughly
- -plug in the power to run the appliance again.

## Troubleshooting

**Caution!** Make sure the power supply is disconnected. Only a qualified electrician can do the trouble-shooting that is not in this manual.

Important! There are some sounds during normal use (compressor, refrigerant circulation).
