- This product is for domestic indoor use only. If this product is used for any commercial, industrial, rental or other purposes, product warranty will be VOIDED.
- This product is not intended for use by children or persons with reduced physical, sensory
 or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given
 supervision or instruction concerning use of this product by an adult responsible for their safety.
- Mind your children and DO NOT let children play with this product.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Check the voltage indicated on the rating label before using this product.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid hazards.
- Unplug this product from the power source before cleaning and maintenance. Contact German Pool authorized service technician for repair or maintenance of this product.

In the interest of your safety and to ensure the correct use, before installing and first using this product, read this user manual carefully, including its hints and warnings. To avoid unnecessary mistakes and accidents, it is important to ensure that all people using this product are thoroughly familiar with its operation and safety features. Save these instructions and make sure that they remain with this product if it is moved or sold, so that everyone using it through its life will be properly informed on product use and safety.

For the safety of life and property keep the precautions of these user's instructions as the manufacturer is not responsible for damages caused by omission.

Children and Vulnerable People Safety

- This product can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced
 physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been
 given supervision or instruction concerning use of this product in a safe way and understand the
 hazards involved.
- 2. Children aged from 3 to 8 years are not allowed to load and unload this product.
- 3. Children should be supervised to ensure that they DO NOT play with this product.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are aged from 8 years and above and supervised.
- 5. Keep all packaging well away from children. There is risk of suffocation.
- If you are discarding this product, pull the plug out of the socket, cut the connection cable (as close to this product as you can) and remove the door to prevent playing children to suffer electric shock or to close themselves into it.

General Safety

- MARNING! Keep ventilation openings, in this product enclosure or in the built-in structure, clear of obstruction.
- WARNING! DO NOT use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- 3.

 MARNING! DO NOT damage the refrigerant circuit.
- WARNING! DO NOT touch the light bulb if it has been on for a long period of time because it could be very hot (If there is a light in the compartment).
- WARNING! DO NOT locate multiple portable socket-outlets or portable power suppliers at the rear of this product.
- DO NOT store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this product.
- The refrigerant isobutane (R-600a) is contained within the refrigerant circuit of this product, a natural gas with a high level of environmental compatibility, which is nevertheless flammable.
- During transportation and installation of this product, be certain that none of the components of the refrigerant circuit become damaged.
 - Avoid open flames and sources of ignition.
 - Thoroughly ventilate the room in which this product is situated.
- 11. It is dangerous to alter the specifications or modify this product in any way. Any damage to the cord may cause a short circuit, fire and/or electric shock.
- 12. This product is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
 - Staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - Farm houses and by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - Bed and breakfast type environments;
 - Catering and similar non-retail applications.
- **14. MARNING!** The light bulb supplied with this product is a "special use lamp bulb" usable only with this product. This "special use lamp" is not usable for domestic lighting (if there is a light in the compartment).
- 15. Power cord must not be lengthened.
- 16. Make sure that the power plug is not squashed or damaged by the back of this product. A squashed or damaged power plug may overheat and cause a fire.
- 17. Make sure that you can come to the mains plug of this product.
- 18. DO NOT pull the mains cable.
- If the power plug socket is loose, DO NOT insert the power plug. There is a risk of electric shock or fire.
- 20. You must not operate this product without the lamp.

- 21. This product is heavy. Care should be taken when moving it.
- 22. DO NOT remove nor touch items from the freezer compartment if your hands are damp/wet, as this could cause skin abrasions or frost/freezer burns.
- 23. Avoid prolonged exposure of this product to direct sunlight.

Daily Use

- 1. DO NOT put hot objects on the plastic parts in this product.
- 2. DO NOT place food products directly against the rear wall.
- Frozen food must not be re-frozen once it has been thawed out (if there is a freezer compartment).
- Store pre-packed frozen food in accordance with the frozen food manufacturer's instructions (if there is a freezer compartment).
- This product's manufacturer storage recommendations should be strictly adhered to. Refer to relevant instructions.
- DO NOT place carbonated of fizzy drinks in the freezer compartment as it creates pressure on the container, which may cause it to explode, resulting in damage to this product (if there is a freezer compartment).
- Ice Iollies can cause frost burns if consumed straight from this product (if there is a freezer compartment).
- 8. To avoid contamination of food, please respect the following instructions:
 - Opening the door for long periods can cause a significant increase of the temperature in the compartments of this product.
 - Clean regularly surfaces that can come in contact with food.
 - Store raw meat and fish in suitable containers in this product, so that it is not in contact with or drip onto other food.
- 9. If this product is left empty for long periods, switch off, defrost, clean, dry and leave the door open to prevent mould developing within this product.

Care and Cleaning

- Before maintenance, switch off this product and disconnect the mains plug from the mains socket.
- 2. DO NOT clean this product with metal objects.
- 3. DOT NOT use sharp objects to remove frost from this product. Use a plastic scraper.

Installation

For electrical connection carefully follow the instructions given in specific paragraphs.

- Unpack this product and check if there are damages on it. DO NOT connect this product if it is damaged. Report possible damages immediately to the place you bought it. In that case retain packing.
- It is advisable to wait at least four hours before connecting this product to allow the oil to flow back in the compressor.
- Adequate air circulation should be around this product, lacking this leads to overheating. To achieve sufficient ventilation follow the instructions relevant to installation.
- Wherever possible the spacers of this product should be against a wall to avoid touching or catching warm parts (compressor, condenser) to prevent possible burn.
- 5. this product must not be located close to radiators or cookers.
- 6. Make sure that the mains plug is accessible after the installation of this product

Service

- Any electrical work required to do the servicing of this product should be carried out by a qualified electrician or competent person.
- This product must be serviced by an authorized Service Center, and only genuine spare parts must be used.

Energy Saving

- DO NOT put hot food in this product.
- 2. DO NOT pack food close together as this prevents air circulating.
- 3. Make sure food DO NOT touch the back of the compartment(s).
- 4. If electricity goes off, DO NOT open the door(s).
- 5. DO NOT open the door(s) frequently.
- 6. DO NOT keep the door(s) open for too long time.
- 7. DO NOT set the thermostat on exceedingly cold temperatures.
- All accessories, such as drawers, shelves and balconies, should be kept there for lower energy consumption.

Environment Protection





Accessories


Movable shelves

The walls of the fridge compartment are equipped with a series of runners so that the shelves can be positioned as desired.



Door Balconies

Door balconies can be taken out for cleaning. To take out the balcony, carefully pull the balcony in the direction of the arrows until it comes free; after cleaning, reposition it.



Installation

- This product is not intended to be used as a built-in appliance.
- It must be possible to disconnect this product from the mains power supply; the plug must therefore be easily accessible after installation.

Selecting A Suitable Location

- 1. Select a location without direct exposure to sunlight.
- 2. Select a location with enough space for the product doors to open easily.
- Select a location with level (or nearly level) flooring. Accurate leveling is ensured by one or more adjustable feet at the base of the product.
- 4. Allow sufficient space to install the product on a flat surface.
- Allow clearance to the right, left, back and top when installing. This will help reduce power consumption and keep your energy bills lower.
- 6. Keep at least 50mm gap at two sides and back.
- This product should be installed well away from sources of heat such as radiators, boilers, direct sunlight etc.
- 8. Ensure that air can circulate freely around the back of the product.
- 9. To ensure best performance, if the product is positioned below an overhanging wall unit, the minimum distance between the top of the product and the wall unit must be at least 50 mm. Ideally, however, the product should not be positioned below overhanging wall units.

Electrical Connection


- Before plugging in, ensure that the voltage and frequency shown on the rating plate correspond to your domestic power supply.
- This product must be earthed. The power supply cable plug is provided with a contact for this
 purpose. If the domestic power supply socket is not earthed, connect this product to a separate
 earth in compliance with current regulations, consulting a qualified electrician.
- The manufacturer declines all responsibility if the above safety precautions are not observed.
- This product complies with the E.E.C. Directives.

Installation

Space Requirement


Keep enough space on the side of the product to ensure doors can open completely.

Keep at least 50mm gap at the two sides and the back.



Levelling the Unit

To do this, adjust the two levelling feet at the front of the unit.



Before Use

Cleaning The Interior

Before using this product for the first time, wipe the interior and wash all internal accessories with lukewarm water and neutral detergent so as to remove the typical smell of a brand new product, then dry thoroughly.

Note:


Do not use harsh cleansers or abrasive powders, as these will damage the finish.

Setting Temperature of Refrigerator Compartment



- This knob inside the refrigerator compartment is for adjusting the temperature of the refrigerator compartment.
- The internal temperature is controlled by a sensor. There are 3 settings: COLD, COLDER and COLDEST. COLD is the lowest setting and COLDEST is the highest setting. It is recommended to select COLDER setting for normal use.
- This product may not operate at the correct temperature if the ambient temperature is particularly hot or if the product door is opened frequently.

Setting Temperature of the Freezer Compartment



- This slider inside the refrigerator compartment is for adjusting the temperature of the freezer compartment.
- When the slider is positioned towards *, the temperature in the freezer compartment will be higher; if the slider is positioned towards *, the temperature in the freezer compartment will be lower
- It is recommended to position the slider to the middle * for normal use.

- This chart is for user reference only.
- In winter or when temperature is below 16 °C, user should avoid setting freezer compartment on * and refrigerator compartment on COLD.
- To save energy, use only and COLDEST settings for special need (such as quick-freezing or ice-making), and return settings back to normal afterwards.

Freezing Fresh Food

- The freezer drawers are suitable for freezing fresh food and storing frozen food for a long time.
- · Place the fresh food to be frozen in the bottom drawer.
- The freezing process of fresh food requires 24 hours, adding new food to be frozen during this
 period is not recommended.

Storing Frozen Food

When first starting-up or after a period out of use, let the product run at least 2 hours on the coldest setting before putting frozen food in the freezer drawers.

Note:

In the event of accidental defrosting (eg. the power has been off for longer than 9.5 hrs), the defrosted food must be consumed quickly or cooked immediately and then re-frozen (after cooked).

Thawing

- Frozen food, prior to be used, can be thawed in the fridge compartment or at room temperature, depending on the time available for defrosting.
- Small pieces may be cooked while still frozen, directly from the freezer, but note that they will take
 a longer cooking time.

Hints for Freezing

- The recommended maximum quantity of new food which can be frozen in 24 hrs (Daily Freezing Capacity) is 2 kg.
- The freezing process takes 24 hours. No new unfrozen food should be added into the freezer during this period.
- Only freeze top quality, fresh and thoroughly cleaned food.
- Preparing food in small portions will enable it to be rapidly and completely frozen, and more
 convenient to subsequently thaw only the quantity required.
- Wrap the food in aluminum foil or polythene and make sure the packages are airtight.
- DO NOT allow fresh or unfrozen food to touch food which is already frozen, to prevent a rise in temperature of the latter.
- · Lean foods store better and longer than fatty ones; salt reduces the storage life of food.
- Water ices, if consumed immediately after removal from the freezer compartment, can possibly
 cause the skin to be freeze burnt.
- It is recommended to mark the freezing date on each individual pack to enable you to keep tab of the storage time.
- Make sure frozen food is transferred from the retail store to the freezer in the shortest possible time.
- DO NOT open the refrigerator doors frequently or leave them open longer than absolutely necessary.
- Once defrosted, food deteriorates rapidly and cannot be refrozen.
- DO NOT exceed the storage period indicated by the food manufacturer.

Hints for Refrigeration

- DO NOT store warm food or evaporating liquids in the refrigerator.
- Cooked foods, cold dishes, etc. should be covered and may be placed on any shelf.
- For food safety and hygiene purposes, food stored in the fridge compartment should be consumed within one or two days.
- Raw food should be wrapped in polythene bag and placed on the lowest shelf just above the crisper drawer.
- Fruit and vegetables should be thoroughly cleaned and placed in the crisper drawer.
- Butter and cheese should be placed in special airtight containers or wrapped in aluminum foil or
 polythene bags to exclude as much air as possible.
- For energy efficiency, all drawers and shelves must be in their right place in the fridge.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Before cleaning and maintenance, disconnect product from the power source by shutting off the circuit breaker or fuse box, and remove the plug from the mains, to avoid danger of electrical shock!
- DO NOT clean this product with a steam cleaner. Moisture could accumulate in electrical components, danger of electrical shock! Hot vapors can lead to the damage of plastic parts.
- Ethereal oils and organic solvents can attack plastic parts, e.g. lemon juice or the juice from orange peel, butyric acid, cleanser that contain acetic acid.
- This product must be dry before it is placed back into service.

For hygienic reasons the product's interior, including accessories, should be cleaned regularly.

- DO NOT allow ethereal oils, organic solvents or cleansers that contain acetic acid to come into contact with this product's parts.
- 2. DO NOT use any abrasive cleaners.
- 3. Remove the food from the freezer. Store them in a cool place, well covered.
- 4. Switch off the product and remove the plug from the mains.
- 5. Clean the product and the interior accessories with cloth and lukewarm water.
- 6. After cleaning, dry off with a dry cloth
- 7. After everything is dry, place the product back into service.

Replacing The Lamp

The internal light is a LED type. To replace the lamp, please contact German Pool Customer Service & Repair Centre.

Troubleshooting

- Before troubleshooting, disconnect the power supply.
- Only qualified electricians or authorized technicians can carry out troubleshooting not mentioned in this manual.

Note:

Compressor and refrigerant circulation may emit sound during use. This is a normal phenomenon.

Product does not work	Temperature regulation knob is set to COLDEST	Set the knob to a lower setting
	Mains plug is not plugged in or is loose	Insert mains plug properly
	Fuse has blown or is defective	Check fuse, replace if necessary

Product freezes or cools too much	Temperature is set too cold or the product is running on COLDEST	Set the knob to a lower setting temporarily
